Well made throughout, he has scope and freedom on the move, really powered through his hocks, head is just right for his age.

Well made chocolate of good basic type, needs to gain a little confidence.



## JUNIOR DOG

1st Place Catraz Kennels'

**BLACKRANGE CRAKKAJACK**

Yellow who won the class on his movement, not surprising he moves so well when you look at his construction - particularly good in front

2nd Place R Brock's

**DIACUS BY GEORGE**

I liked this yellow's front and balance but he was playing his handler up by stretching himself behind on the stack.

3rd Place Rikim Kennels'

**BLACKHILLS SLEEPY HOLLOW (IMP NZ)**

Yellow of substance, front movement affected by construction. Well set on tail.

## INTERMEDIATE DOG

1st Place Thomas & Robinson's

**CH LASKELSA WILD DESTINY**

Lovely clean head with no cheekiness and a good length of muzzle, lovely eye colour, good hindquarters and moved very well. Nicely balanced. Would have preferred less weight.

2nd Place B Read's

**CH GUNSMITH POWER READER**

Smaller dog who could do with a touch more length of leg for me.

3rd Place Bird, Hann & Spouncer's

**CHEYANDOR WILSON**

Nice head when relaxed but not happy today. Balanced and clean, but front could be better.





### AUSTRALIAN BRED DOG

1st Place F & A McIver's

**CH HAPPYBLACK SPRUCE BRUCE**

I really liked this dog. Lovely substance and clean lines and general look of quality. On another day he could very easily have been my winner.

2nd Place G & R Paunovic's

**CH SHAUNDER BLACK TYCOON**

Sweet black with kindest expressions, correct coat, lovely dark eye colour (not too dark).

3rd Place B Read's

**CH GUNSMITH GOLDEN LIGHT**

Larger cast yellow who was looking very smart. However, for me, his front was a little disappointing.

### OPEN DOG

1st Place S Power's

**CH ZENCHEL SLICK WILLY (AI)**

What a star. 11½ years of age and still enjoying every minute of it. It was only after I finished judging that I realised where my Reserve CC winner got his attitude from. Whilst they are both what I would describe as traditional black type, in some ways I was surprised that they were father and son as for me the extra scope of Happy Days and rawness gives the impression of size and the maturity of Slick Willy somehow makes him look like he is out of a smaller mould. Excellent in the breed essentials of coat, head and lovely otter tail well set on.



2nd Place E Gent's

**CH ENELEON TIGERS EYE (IMP UK)**

Masculine, but retains a very kind expression. Upstanding yellow, excellent bone and good length of leg. Looking at my catalogue later I noted how many of his progeny had done well.

3rd Place S & D Wilkie's

**CH WILGUNNDI PLAINS STORM**

Dark chocolate. I really think this dog earned his place. His movement was super and he is such a lovely type, very good leg length to body depth ratios.

Typey black, excellent head and coat. Needs to clean out through neck.

3rd Place T & G Wilson's

**CATRAZ PIPERS SERENADE**

Pretty baby with clean outline, good coat texture and lovely root to her tail.

### MINOR PUPPY BITCH

1st Place L Adams'

**LABEANA FOREIGN IMPACT**

Well balanced yellow who will need time (as they should).

2nd Place Catraz Kennels'

**CATRAZ GOLLY MISS MOLLY**

Nicely balanced and of good type, excelled on the move.

3rd Place Janvalli Kennels'

**CATRAZ ANNIE OAKLEY**

Lovely type. Just needs to come up on her legs.

For me a touch more length of muzzle would help, but she has well set ears and a kind expression. Excels in front construction giving that lovely keel to her forechest - something that is becoming rarer all the time.

3rd Place A & M McCleary's

**CLEMKIRK TOLD YOU SO**

Paler chocolate with excellent undercoat. Excellent legs and feet nicely made.

### JUNIOR BITCH

An interesting class with the first three with little to split them. In the end I settled for the lovely head of the winner, for me she has a touch more scope and she is also a real showgirl. All three had good necks, firm toplines and ribs. The second and third were well boned and I also noted no 3's lovely eye colour and pigment.

1st Place A O'Connor's **ARALYEN MOMENT IN TIME**

Black won the class on her lovely head.

2nd Place Hann & Spouncer's **CHEYANDOR XENA**

Black. Good ribs and forechest.

3rd Place D & L Pemberton's **CHEYANDOR XANTHINE**

Yellow. Interesting to see later that they are sisters.



### INTERMEDIATE BITCH

1st Place Thomas & Robinson's **CH LASKELSA LITTL DIVA**

Yellow of quality. My Res CC winner. So correct in so many ways. Lovely size, correct amount of bone, good front giving correct forechest, level topline.

2nd Place Taikuri Kennels' **TAIKURI UNDERSTUDY**

Clean and scopey black who is very showy. A close thing between this one and the winner.

3rd Place F & A Mclver's **CH HAPPYBLACK FLIRTY GERTIE**

Another good one. A shade longer cast but well balanced and with excellent ribs.

1st Place T & G Wilson's **CH BLACKRANGE WATERWITCH**

Lovely black in full coat and nicely made in all departments. She has lovely type and balance. Kind head and expression. Pleasing outline both standing and on the move. In her prime, fully mature and has real quality. CC.

2nd Place E Gent's **CH GUNNISLAKE TIGER LILY**

Pale cream. A different type but so correct in so many ways. Pretty head. Another close decision. Particularly good width to hindquarters.

3rd Place Hann & Spouncer's **SHAUNDAR STORY TELLER**

Her lovely front earned her this placing in a very good class. Lovely coat texture and good pigment.

Not the greatest showgirl, but so old fashioned and I loved her balance and excellent length of muzzle on a very correct head.
