SO YOU WANT TO BREED YOUR LABRADOR?

As a member of the Labrador Retriever Club of Victoria Inc, you may wish to prepare your dog or bitch for a breeding career.

To register your litter with the Victorian Canine Association, the Sire and Dam must have their hips and elbows scored by an ANKC approved reader and the following procedures need to be followed by both the owner and the Veterinary Surgeon.

- **It is your responsibility to ensure that all certificates are completed correctly – altered certificates will not be accepted.**
- **Do not assume that your vet will fill in the form correctly!**
 1. **Make sure that you take a copy of your dog/bitch's V.C.A. registration certificate with you to give to your Veterinary Surgeon to submit with the x-ray to ensure that the radiographer has all the information to include on the certificates.**
 2. **Make sure that your dog/bitch is scanned by your Veterinary Surgeon to determine it's positive identification number which is to be included on the x-rays and certificates.**
- **When you are registering your litter with the Victorian Canine Association, you will need to forward certified (as a true copy of the original) copies of the Hip and Elbow certificates to the Victorian Canine Association.**

Below is a checklist that may assist you to ensure that x-rays and certificates are correct.
